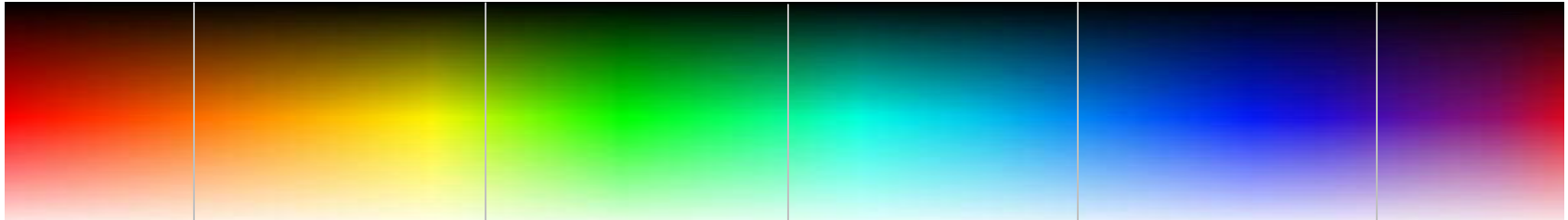

Nurse Practitioner Healthcare

Health Savings Accounts (HSAs)

Health Savings Accounts (HSAs) are innovative plans designed to help individuals save for qualified medical and retiree expenses on a tax-free basis. Health Savings Accounts can be offered to employers when combined with a qualifying high deductible health insurance plan.

Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP)

HIP is for uninsured Hoosier adults between the ages of 19-64 who do not qualify or have access to group coverage, Medicare, or Medicaid. Services include: physician services, prescriptions, diagnostic exams, home health services, inpatient and outpatient hospital, hospice, preventive services, family planning, and case and disease management. Contributions are made by the State and each participant (based on ability to pay) or their employer.

Health and Wellness Programs

The Wellness Program at Columbus Regional Hospital offers a 15% discount on all Wellness Program Fitness Classes for all employees of any Chamber member. Also, Business Resource Group—a division of Centerstone (formerly Quinco Behavioral Health Systems)—offers SOLUTIONS EAP, a program that assists employers to manage human capital risk through reducing the problems that keep employees from being productive at work.
